**SEASONAL PUBLIC UTILITY NON-EMERGENCY EXEMPTION PERMIT
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. The driver of the vehicle shall carry this permit in the vehicle to which it applies and shall have it available for inspection by any police officer or agent of the Kalamazoo County Road Commission (KCRC) or Michigan Public Service Commission.
2. Applicant shall be responsible for any damage caused to wires, mailboxes, and trees on the highway, and shall reimburse the owners or persons in charge for any property damage caused by the moving of said vehicle or load, and shall save harmless and indemnify the Kalamazoo County Road Commission from all suits, damages, and proceedings of every kind arising out of the presence on and use of the highway of said vehicle and load.
3. The speed of the vehicle shall not exceed that shown on this permit and load shall not exceed normal legal axel loading.
4. Vehicles shall be registered as required by the Michigan statutes and will not violate any statute or valid ordinance, rule, or regulation by any state agency or sub-division of the state. Vehicles are to comply with all statutory provisions as to other permits, licensing, motor vehicle equipment, and operation, including proper load securement.
5. Permits will in no way supersede posted axle loading limits on any bridge, culvert or roadway. The applicant agrees to reimburse the KCRC for any damage resulting from the disregard of such postings.
6. The vehicle shall not be loaded or unloaded within the outer shoulder limits of any county road.
7. Permits are invalidated automatically by violation of any of the conditions specified by the terms of the permit or by false information given on the application. Failure to comply with the conditions of this permit shall be just cause for the immediate suspension or revocation of any or all permits and the operator and/or owner of the vehicle may be subject to arrest.
8. Weather conditions may require temporary suspension of right-of-way work and use of this permit.
