

July 12, 2010-Alamo Township

A joint meeting of the Board of County Road Commissioners of Kalamazoo County and the Alamo Township Board of Trustees was held at the Alamo Township Hall, 7901 N. 6th Street, Kalamazoo, Michigan, on Monday, July 12, 2010. The joint meeting began at 6:00 p.m.

Following introductions, Commissioner McCauley reviewed agenda items as follows; review of 2005-2009 Alamo Township local road projects with an update by General Superintendent Bartholomew, the Alamo Township PASER rating which Commissioner Oscarson noted was a tool to build a 5-year plan, 2010 Primary Road Capital Improvement Projects and the 2010-2014 Primary Road Capital Improvement Plan. Also, discussed was the Transportation Economic Development Fund resolution for 12th Street, 5th Street and the Uniform Traffic Code as it relates to the Weighmaster position with the County Sheriff. The Local road participation fund policy was also reviewed with key dates and funding.

Deputy Supervisor Fisher inquired if KCRC could track savings of aggregate based on Aggregate Industries supply. Trustee Potter-Williams inquired if there was further follow up to a phone call that was received by dispatch regarding storm damage tree removal. General Superintendent Bartholomew noted dispatch has a complete list of KCRC contacts. She also noted a service request for tree removal was handled well.

Commissioner McCauley expressed appreciation to the Alamo Township Board of Trustees for scheduling the joint meeting.
